

Karate Canada 2018 National Championships NCCP Policy

(Updated November 10th, 2017)

In order to assure that Provincial Coaching staff is obtaining the proper training to provide their athletes with the best possible support and in alignment with Sport Canada expectations, Karate Canada is establishing the following requirements for coaches who wish to participate in the National Championships and other coaching related events:


1) For 2018 National Championships, all coaches must have achieved a minimum of Competition Introduction "Trained" status, 50% of any provincial coaching staff must have achieved a minimum of Competition Development "In-Training" status including the karate specific module, 3 Comp Dev multisport modules and the Making Ethical Decisions (course or evaluation). Any designated head coaches must have achieved Competition Development "Certified" status – which requires the coach successfully completes the Evaluation process before the start of the Nationals.

Any higher NCCP level of training or certification will also be considered as valid. Karate Canada will verify all coach NCCP credentials and records via The Locker (the Coaching Association of Canada's online database) after the registration deadline and prior to the start of competition. Extenuating circumstances for not satisfying the established requirements may be considered by Karate Canada.
