1. THE PROGRAM

- Approximately 9 hours of technical, physical & tactical training, plus 1 hour of theory & education and 1 hour of team building.
- Physical, technical and tactical kumite and kata training sessions, assembling Senior National Team Roster members, medalists from the 2022 Karate Canada Senior Team Trials (Calgary, AB), and all PTSO athletes trying out for their Provincial Teams this season.
- Specific kata and kumite training sessions for current Senior National Team members, in preparation for the 2022 Senior Pan American Championships.
- All participating Senior National Team athletes selected for participation in the 2022 Senior Pan American Karate Championships will be provided with a final preparation plan for that event.
- Information sessions for all on Karate Canada's Senior National Team Program, for both kata and kumite.
- In addition to the three National Team Coaches, Assistant National Team Coaches and Dojo Coaches will also be helping Staff Coaches with delivery of the training sessions.
- Medical support staff will be available during all training and testing sessions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Junior and Senior National Team Roster members, and all PTSO elite division athletes (in good standing with their PTSO) as well as the participants in the 2022 Senior Team Trials are eligible for participation in this training camp.


